On February 17, 2022, Azure College's accrediting agency, the Accrediting Bureau of Health Education Schools (ABHES), advised the College that it was withdrawing the College's accreditation, subject to the College's right to appeal the decision. The College has exercised its right of appeal, and the ABHES decision to withdraw the College's accreditation is stayed until the appeal process is completed, which is expected to take 60-90 days. **Azure College remains accredited during the appeal process.**

ABHES also has directed Azure College to submit a Teachout Plan. The Teachout Plan lists other institutions that offer similar programs that potentially could enter into teachout agreements with the College if its appeal is not successful and describes a record retention.
